Flashlight Operation

The single push button switch on the top of the flashlight incorporates a battery status indicator.

1. To turn on the flashlight, push once on the switch. This will activate the light at full brightness.
2. To activate the dimming feature, push the switch within three seconds after step (1).
3. To activate strobe feature, push the switch within three seconds after step (2).
4. To turn the light off, push the switch after three seconds on any of the above steps.

Battery Status Indicator

This light includes a battery status indicator incorporated into the switch. When the light is activated, the opaque switch boot will turn:

Attaching the Power Cord

Before attempting to charge the flashlight, the power cord plug should be installed into the socket located on the underside of the charger base. Once the plug is installed, push the cord into the channel.

Flashlight Charging

- » Set the 9415i flashlight on the charger slots.
- » Push the flashlight down while sliding it backwards and release (see diagram).
- » The LED indicator light in the rear of the charger base will turn flashing RED indicating charging is in process. When the light turns solid GREEN charging is complete.

It is not necessary to remove the flashlight at this point as the charger will then only give a maintenance charge.

Battery Replacement

To Replace the Battery Pack

1. Use a Philips screwdriver to remove six screws on the bottom housing.
2. Carefully unplug the connectors. (as shown)
3. Remove the battery pack.

To Install the Battery Pack

1. Place the battery pack (use battery pack catalog #9418Z0 only) into the battery compartment.
2. Carefully connect the connectors on the battery pack to the connectors on the flashlight.
3. Replace the bottom housing and replace and tighten the six screws by hand. Do not over tighten!

YOUR 9415i ARRIVES WITH THE BATTERY PACK PARTIALLY CHARGED. BEFORE USE, CHARGE THE FLASHLIGHT FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS.

Vehicle Installations

The charger base is approved to NFPA vehicular mounting specifications. It is recommended that the charger be mounted onto a horizontal surface to prevent accidental ejection of the flashlight. The charger can be secured via the four counterbore 3/8" diameter holes located on the top of the front and rear surfaces. Phillips screws are recommended.

A professional auto electrician should be used to wire the charger into the electrical system of a vehicle. Connect the charger to the electrical system of the vehicle so that there is no ignition-related interrupt. This will prevent the charger from rapidly charging the battery pack unnecessarily. When the battery pack is charged, the current draw from the charger in trickle mode will not excessively drain the vehicle's battery.

Conditions of Safe Use

1. The LED Head Assembly is covered with a conductive coating to avoid the build-up of an electrostatic charge. This coating is humidity independent and the operating temperature range is up to 155°C. Do not use the flashlight in a Hazardous Area if the coating is flaking or peeling.
2. The maximum measured capacitance of exposed metal parts is 13pF.
3. Approved for use with Pelican catalog #9418Z0 NIIMH battery pack only.

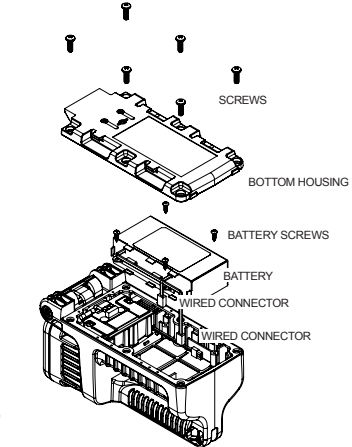
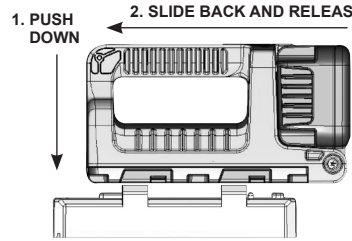
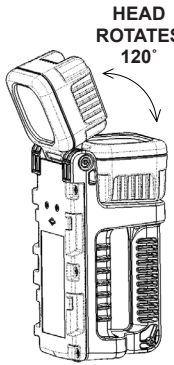

El interruptor, que se encuentra en la parte superior de la linterna, presenta un indicador de carga de la batería.

1. Para encender la linterna, pulsar una vez el interruptor. Se activará a la máxima intensidad.
2. Para activar la función de atenuación, pulsar el interruptor antes de que transcurran tres segundos del paso (1).
3. Para activar el modo intermitente, pulsar el interruptor antes de que transcurran tres segundos del paso (2).
4. Para apagar la linterna desde cualquiera de los modos anteriores, esperar 3 segundos para pulsar el interruptor.

Indicador De Carga De La Batería

Esta linterna presenta un indicador de carga de la batería integrado en el interruptor.

Al encender la linterna, la cubierta opaca del interruptor se iluminará:

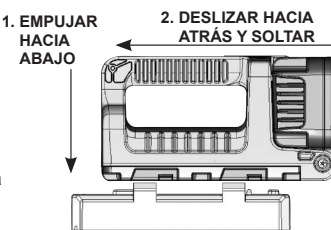
Antes de cargar la linterna es preciso enchufar el cable de alimentación a la toma de la base del cargador. Una vez enchufado, insertar el cable en el canal.

Cargar La Linterna

- » Colocar la linterna 9415i en las ranuras del cargador.
- » Empujar la linterna hacia abajo y hacia atrás y a continuación soltarla. (ver diagrama)
- » La luz LED del indicador de la parte de atrás de la base del cargador empezará a parpadear en ROJO para indicar que la carga está en proceso; cuando la luz se vuelva VERDE la carga se habrá completado.

No es necesario retirar la linterna de inmediato, ya que el cargador tan solo suministrará una carga de mantenimiento.
